
## TURKEY SHOOT — A Radical International Conspiracy Literary Thriller

IT'S OCTOBER 2015. Meet Mahmoud al Ramadi, 23, an Iragi victim of ISIS who has become what some would call a freedom fighter. The antihero of this unconventional thriller is softspoken yet militant, someone who by almost anyone's definition could be a terrorist. Fresh from battling ISIS in Syria, he floats to Greece among other displaced people where, in Piraeus, he adopts terrorism—or more precisely, terrorists adopt him. The ambitious operation his new comrades are plotting will, he is informed, decimate the power elite and inspire revolution around the globe. Having vowed payback for war crimes that orphaned him, the devout Iraqi accepts the mission as his jihad. His thousand-mile odyssey from war-torn Mosul to strife-ridden Athens and part way back tests his metal, his wits, and his abiding faith.



You'll find memorable characters, tense action, straight and gay romance, ideological and other altercations, and ingenious improvisations in both the real and virtual worlds in this gripping read. How you'll feel about their rogue operation and its dénouement depends on who you are and what you stand for, but it could be complicated. All that Mahmoud experiences edits his articles of faith and just might edit some of yours.

A former academic widely recognized for innovations in digital mapping, **Geoffrey Dutton** moved to industry as a developer, analyst, consultant, and eventually a technical communicator, telling computer users what they should and shouldn't do. Gnawing unease over where tech was taking us led him to quit the biz and unlearn expository style to write whatever suited his fancy. Over the last half decade he's variously posted over 400 articles, essays, stories, and memoirs at Progressive Pilgrim Review, CounterPunch, and Medium. His *Petit Mal*, a tragic short story narrated by a grumpy malware-infested PC, was recently published the anthology As Told by Things. For the past three years, his attention was focused on researching, writing, and revising Turkey Shoot, a cinema verité inside-out pageturner that parachutes you into a world of "evildoers" and even makes you root for them.
